Meaning

> The Future Continuous Tense is used to express an ongoing action in future.



Example: She will be cooking tonight.

The above example conveys the ongoing nature of an action (cooking) which will occur in future.

Here's how to make a sentence in future continuous tense: (will + be + verb-ing)

➤ Examples:

- 1) I will be working. (will + be + work-ing)
- 2) He will be studying tomorrow. (will + be + study-ing)
